An active member of the ACCQ for under two years with a career horizon of at least a decade as of November 7, 2024.

- The nomination must be submitted by the local president and seconded by a member of the local executive.
- The form must be completed, duly signed, and returned by email to <u>candidature@accq.qc.ca</u> <u>no later than</u> October 11, 2024. Only the information included in the said form will be analyzed by the jury.
